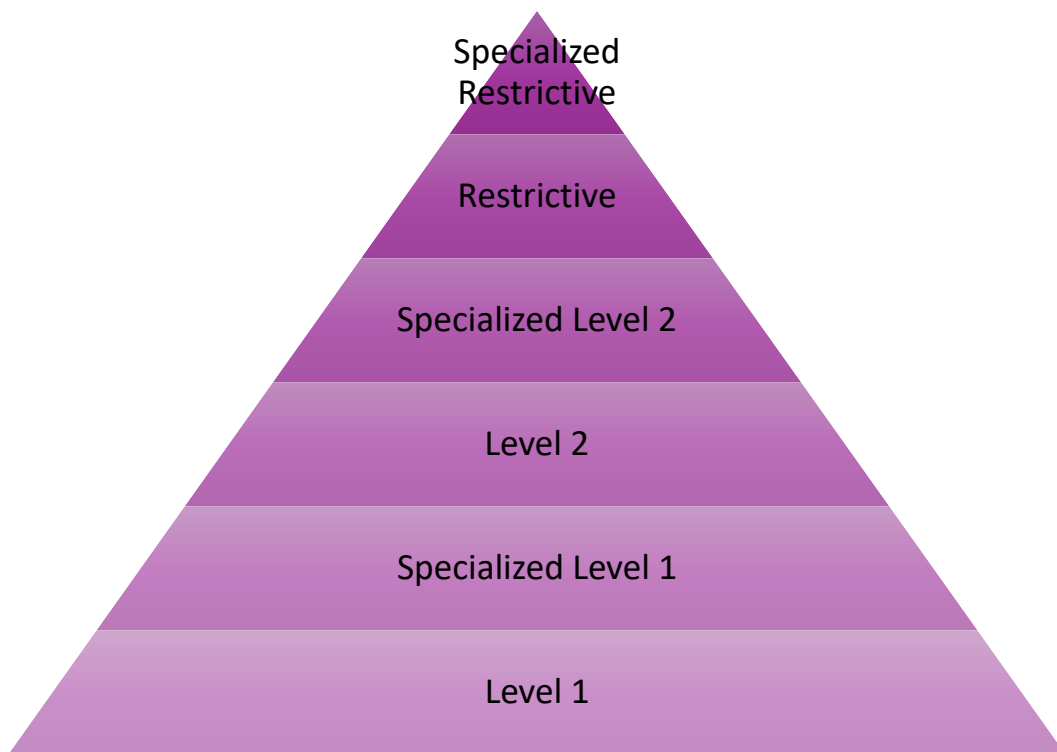


PROMOTE Training Levels

This document shows the different levels training staff may receive as part of the PROMOTE training curriculum. PROMOTE focuses on using positive interactions to help serve individuals and meet their behavioral needs. These positive interactions are focused on preventing challenging behaviors and building the individual's skills to replace those behaviors. However, some individuals have challenging behaviors that require staff to know additional behavior interventions and responses. In these cases, staff will receive additional training to meet the individual's needs safely and appropriately. Staff are only trained to the level needed to meet the needs of the individuals they serve.



Most individuals can have their behavioral needs met with staff who are trained at Level 1. As you move further up the pyramid, you can see that fewer individuals need these more specialized and restrictive interventions. Therefore, fewer staff will need this additional training.

Just as a pyramid builds upon itself, staff training builds upon itself. Therefore, before staff can be trained in a higher level of PROMOTE, they must receive the training levels before it (except for Specialized Level 1, which may be skipped if the interventions aren't needed for someone who needs interventions in Specialized Level 2).
